Regulations

- Exhibitors please note that pot size is limited to 300mm across the top. Hanging containers and potted Palms Excepted.
- Every care will be taken of all exhibits, but the Show Society will not be responsible for any damage thereto, or Loss thereof.
- Entries close at 12 noon, Friday June 11<sup>th</sup> 2010. Judging will take place during the afternoon.
- NO late entries will be accepted.
- Entries may not be removed from the pavilion before 4PM Sunday June 13<sup>th</sup> 2010.
- Entries must be of own original work
- Pot plants must have been in the possession of the exhibitor for at least one-month prior to entry.
- Entries may be eligible for more than one class.

Entry Fee: \$2.00 per entry

Prize Money: 1<sup>st</sup> - \$10.00; 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$5.00; 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$2.00

A plaque will be awarded to the most successful exhibitor. Points awarded will be 3 for first, 2 for second, and 1 for third.

4	One Begonia
5	One Philodendron
6	One Variegated Foliage Plant
7	One cactus or Succulent
8	One Zygocactus, <i>Schlumbergia</i>
9	One Bromeliad, shown for foliage
10	One Bromeliad, show for flower
11	One miniature garden, minimum of 3 varieties of plants in any container
12	One African Violet

CUT FLOWERS

13	Single Gerbera or double Gerbera
14	One Rosebud
15	One Rose
16	One Flower of any other type

## COLLECTION

- 17 Roses, no more than six
- 18 Gerberas, no more than six
- 19 Bouganvillea, double or single, no more than six pieces 350mm each
- 20 Any other flower, no more than six of same

## FLORAL ART

- 21 Table arrangement, fresh flowers
- 22 Basket arrangement, fresh or dried flowers
- 23 Freestyle arrangement in a container of choice
- 24 Theme arrangement (own choice), fresh or dried
