- Entries close at 12 noon, Friday June 08th 2012. Judging will take place during the afternoon.
- NO late entries will be accepted.
- Entries may not be removed from the pavilion before 4PM Sunday June 10th 2012
- Entries must be of own original work
- Pot plants must have been in the possession of the exhibitor for at least one-month prior to entry.
- Entries may be eligible for more than one class.

Entry Fee: \$2.00 per entry

Prize Money: 1st - \$10.00; 2nd - \$5.00; 3rd - \$2.00

MOST SUCCESSFUL EXHIBITOR will receive a certificate and plaque. Points awarded will be 1st: 3, 2nd: 2, 3rd: 1

9	One Bromeliad, shown for foliage
10	One Bromeliad, shown for flower
11	One miniature garden, minimum of 3 varieties of plants in any container
12	One African Violet
13	Any other Pot Plant not listed

14	Single Gerbera or double Gerbera
15	One Rosebud
16	One Rose
17	One Flower of any other type

COLLECTION

- 18 Roses, no more than six
- 19 Gerberas, no more than six
- 20 Bougainvillea, double or single, no more than six pieces 350mm each
- 21 Any other flower, no more than six of same

- 22 Basket arrangement, fresh or dried flowers
- 23 Freestyle arrangement in a container of choice
